#### Student Rules and Responsibilities:

- 1. No one may use another person's login or password to enter, copy, alter, or tamper with computer files and setup.
- 2. Students are not allowed to use computers for anything other than schoolwork. *The use of e-mail, instant messages, chat rooms, and non-educational games is <u>not</u> permitted, unless explicitly approved by the instructor <u>and</u> <i>Administration.*
- 3. Students my not bring, download, or install unauthorized software. All copyright laws are to be strictly followed.
- 4. No student may tamper with the setup of school computers, intentionally introduce a software virus, or take equipment that has not been assigned to him/her. This includes: NO downloading files or programs from the Internet or changing the appearance of a computer screen or desktop in any way.
- 5. No one may abuse hardware or software or use technology for any malicious purpose.
- 6. Food, drinks, chewing gum, or eating candy around the computer equipment is strictly prohibited.
- 7. Anyone witnessing the violation of any of the above provisions is expected to report the violation to the appropriate teacher or administrator.

### Breaking any of these rules may lead to loss of computer privileges at Pleasant Valley High School, detention or suspension.
