

Girls Soccer 2017-18

1. Girls Soccer Information meeting – An informational meeting will be held for girls planning to try-out for the 2017-2018 varsity and junior varsity soccer team. **The informational meeting will be Thursday, Sept 21st at noon in Stefanie Volk’s classroom, O6.** All interested soccer players should plan to attend. Information will be shared regarding try-out dates/times, along with how best to prepare for upcoming try-outs.
2. All soccer players must have completed a sports physical prior to try-outs. A hard copy of doctor’s physical form must be turned in prior to trying out for the soccer team.
3. In order to participate in athletics, all players must complete the mandatory On-Line Athletic Eligibility Packet, each year. Parent/Guardian and Student each must complete the packet. Links to the packets are available through your Parent and Student Aeries Portals. This must be completed prior to trying out for soccer November 1st.
4. Try-out dates – girls soccer try-outs will be held on the dates/times noted below. Any athlete participating in a fall sport during try-outs times will be provided alternative try-out times, upon completion of the fall sports season. Players will be given an opportunity to try-out regardless of conflicts in schedule. Please contact either the soccer coach (Eric Snedeker / Stefanie Volk) or athletic director (Pam Jackson) prior to try-outs to discuss any scheduling conflicts. Try-outs are open to all 9-12th grade students enrolled at Pleasant Valley High School for the 2017-2018 school term.
