Course Descriptions

Introduction to Public Safety/Careers 911 (Introductory)

This course is the Introductory Level course in the Public Safety Pathway and prepares high school students for work in entry-level positions in Public Safety through classroom instruction, hands-on training and community experience. This pathway encompasses career opportunities in a variety of jobs in which the focus is ensuring the general safety and public service to the community. The careers included in this pathway primarily address public order, fire protection, social services and emergency medical services.

Administration of Justice (Concentrator)

This course provides an introduction to the history, philosophy, and agencies of the administration of justice system. Emphasis will be placed on crime, punishment, rehabilitation, ethics, education, Emergency Medicine – including First Aid & CPR, Self Defense, and professionalism in the system. Knowledge related to law enforcement duties will be covered, including investigations, report writing, search & seizure, patrol procedures, prison & juvenile systems, and private investigations. Instruction will include lectures, discussions, guest speakers, hands-on activities, demonstrations, field trips, and other community partnerships. This course is eligible for Butte College 2 + 2 articulation.
