## Even if you have never studied Japanese or Spanish, you can help your student to have a successful and enjoyable year.

#### Ask your student about class!

- Let your student explain to you the language and cultural ideas that we study in class.
- Help your student to understand the difference between homework and studying.
- Offer to go through the English side of the flashcards. It helps to study with a partner.
- Encourage your student to talk about class progress and concerns.

#### Tell your student to ask for help!

- Encourage your student to attend Tutorials and Study Sessions offered by the FL department.
- Remind your student to check the Tutorial Calendar in the classroom to find a time to get help.
- Offer to arrange a meeting with the teacher, student, parent and or counselor as necessary.
- Consider hiring a language tutor if necessary.

#### Remind your student to do these things.

- Spend 15-20 minutes studying each day. Practice every night at home (in addition to doing homework.)
- Set achievable goals.
- Pay attention in class and ask questions- make good use of in class time.
- Make flashcards, write the words many times, use word associations- do whatever is necessary to learn!
- Get to know some classmates- get phone numbers or emails and practice together!
- Take a snack or stretch break- and get back to work. It's hard to do HW when you're tired.
- Attend class, do the assignments and <u>be involved in the lesson.</u> This one hour is your chance to learn a foreign language.
- Don't expect to understand everything! Expect to make mistakes but to learn from them.

#### Bring language into you home!

Watch movies, attend cultural events, cook target culture meals and visit local restaurants.

Go to your room!	Heya ni ikinasai 部屋に行きなさい	Vete al dormitorio.
