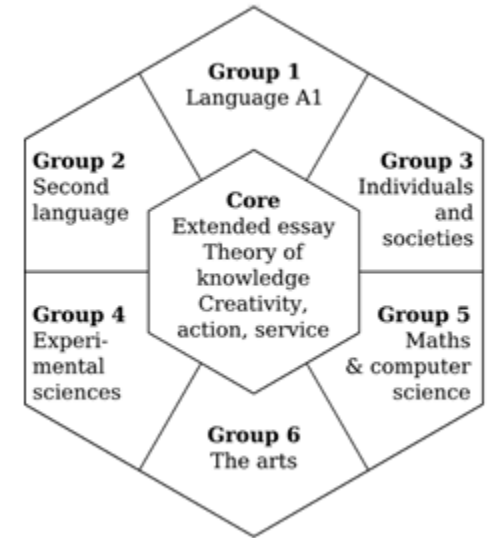

Full IB Diploma candidates must complete three Higher Level (HL) courses and three Standard Level (SL) courses during their junior (maximum of two taken in Junior Year) and senior years. These courses must cover the five major subject areas and one elective subject. Diploma candidates must also take IB Theory of Knowledge, complete the Extended essay and complete the CAS requirements.
